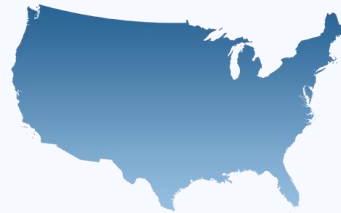

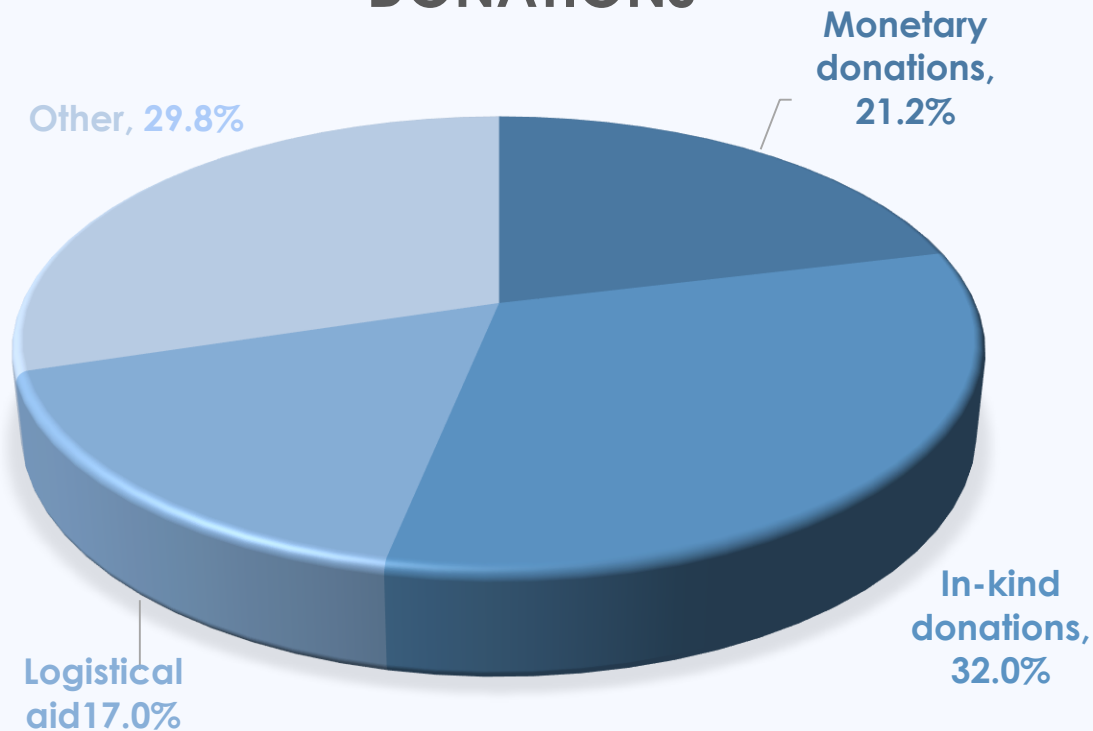




MILESTONES REACHED

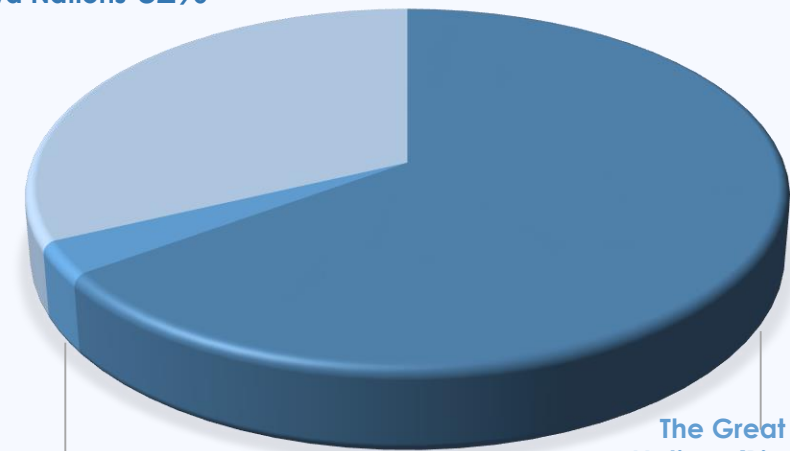


AID DISTRIBUTION

LOVE IN ACTION ... OUR VOLUNTEERS





ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR PHASE I WINTER 2020-2021

We are seeking \$20,000 in funding to continue to provide Phase I relief support to the communities to continue to cope with COVID-19 impact especially during winter 2020-2021.

- **\$8,000** to provide nutritional foods and immune-busting, anti-viral herbal medicines;
- **\$6,000** for sanitizing and cleaning supplies;
- **\$3,000** for water access solutions (water barrels, water tanks and pumps for the Hopi and Navajo communities;
- **\$3,000** for tools to prepare for winter (wood splitters, chainsaws, shovels, buckets, lumber)



NEXT PHASE 2021:

Antinanco and PAZA are seeking \$350,000 for the next phase of the project to accomplish the following:

- ❖ Provide nutritional and wellness kits
- ❖ Provide tools and ingredients to re-establish traditional practices
- ❖ Provide education on in-home sanitation, preventative wellness, integration of nutritious foods and supplements, taking into the account the needs of elders
- ❖ Involve local food producers in the Project, contributing to the local economies
- ❖ Involve the communities' youth in these initiatives
